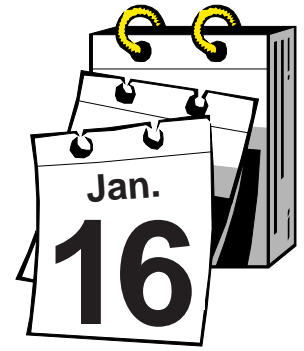


Old Torrance Neighborhood Assoc.
